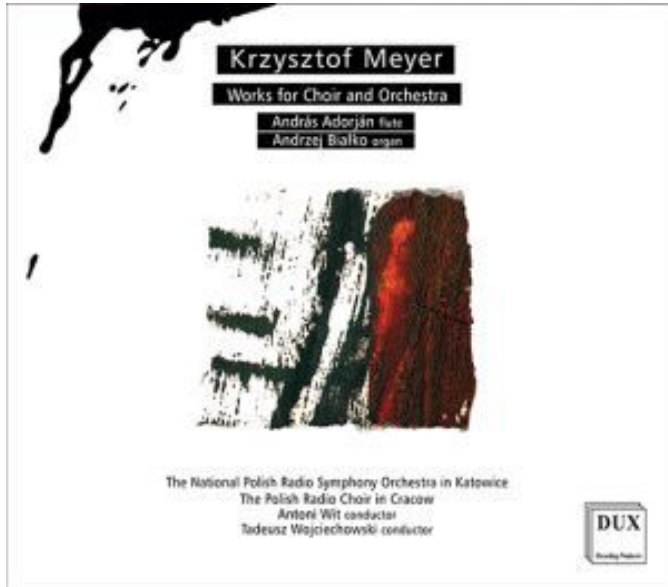

Product description

The next CD presents **Krzysztof Meyer's** artistic achievements, one of the most prominent contemporary Polish composers. The protagonist of three initial pieces on the CD is instrumental music in which varied narration and drama is developed on the basis of heterogeneous sounds; from plenty of musical erudition *Hommage à Johannes Brahms*, through virtuoso *Concerto No. 2 for Flute and Orchestra*, to reflexive *Farewell Music* dedicated to Witold Lutosławski. The expressive climax of the CD is constituted by *Mass for Mixed Choir, Organ and Orchestra* - both expressive and plenty of intelligent references to the history of this perhaps most demanding genre in the times of the European art of composing.
